In order to minimize the environmental footprint of the meeting and in line with the UN policy towards greener meetings, participants are kindly reminded to bring their own copies of the documents, or to use paperless versions, as there will be no extra copies made available on site during the meeting. #### 5. General information on access to Oslo

Oslo is serviced by the Oslo Gardermoen Airport which is about 35 km from the city centre. The airport express train - Flytoget costs about NOK 230 (about US \$22), the Regional and local trains - VY costs about NOK 118 (about US \$12) all trains bring you to the central station in downtown Oslo, and the trip takes about 20 minutes. Taxis are also available at the airport, it is recommended that you go to the taxi booking machine located outside the terminal building, ground level (near taxi pick up), book using the booking machine which will show prices, taxi should arrive

within 3-5 minutes of booking. The approximate cost of a taxi is about NOK 945 during the day (US \$92) and NOK 11,56 (US \$113) between 17:00 and 06:00 and on weekends.

#### 6. Visa information

Participants from all other countries are required to obtain a Schengen visa to enter Norway and are strongly advised to contact the nearest Norwegian diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure. **Please note that airline companies will not allow boarding in the absence of a valid visa.**

#### 7. Health information

All COVID-19 entry requirements for Norway have been lifted. Therefore, vaccinations, pre-boarding testing, are not required for all travellers. However, it is recommended that you carry your vaccination certificates in case of need. The World Health Organization (WHO) continues to recommend the use of masks by the public in specific situations, masks are recommended following a recent exposure to COVID-19, when someone has or suspects they have COVID-19, when someone is at high-risk of severe COVID-19, and for anyone in a crowded, enclosed, or poorly ventilated space. Participants are requested to bring their own masks.

## 9. Payment of the Daily Subsistence Allowance (DSA)

The relevant portion of DSA will be disbursed to funded participants on the first day of the meeting in the form of a prepaid credit card (Swiss Bankers card). These funded participants are kindly requested to bring their passports and boarding passes on the first day of the meeting. These will be photocopied and returned to participants during the meeting. It is advisable that participants have some cash at hand to cover expenses that may occur between their arrival and the moment at which they are provided with the prepaid credit card from which they will access their DSA. Please note that the funds can take up to 24 hours to be loaded on the cards.

## 11. Weather and time zone information



In November, the average temperatures in Oslo typically range between +3°C in the daytime and -1°C at night. Please bring appropriate clothing for cold conditions. The current weather conditions may be found at https://worldweather.wmo.int/en/city.html?cityId=21.

The standard time zone for Oslo is CEST (Central European Standard Time) which is GMT/UTC + 2 hours.

## 12. Electricity

The electrical currents in Norway are 220-240 Volts, 50 Hertz same as in Europe and plugs are as shown below.



## 13. Currency



The currency in Norway is the Norwegian Kroner (NOK or kr). The current exchange rate as of 5 October 2023 is USD \$1 = NOK 10.97 and \$0 = NOK 11.57 (source: <a href="https://www.xe.com">www.xe.com</a>, rates are subject to change).

Currency exchange facilities are readily available in banks and hotels.
