

#### 1. **Opening and registration**

The Regional Workshop to Facilitate the Description of Ecologically or Biologically Significant Marine Areas in the North-East Atlantic Ocean and Training Session on EBSAs will be held in Stockholm, Sweden, from Sunday, 22 September, to Friday, 27 September 2019.

The meeting will start at 9:00 a.m. on Sunday, 22 September, and registration will take place at the venue of the meeting at 8:30 a.m. the same day.

### 5. General information on access to Stockholm



Stockholm is serviced by the Stockholm Arlanda International Airport (ARN) (40 km from downtown). You can reach the city by train, bus or taxi. The information is as follows.

<u>Train</u>

An express train (Arlanda Express) departs every 15 minutes during the day, and every 30 minutes during the night. The train takes 20 minutes and arrives at and departs from platforms 1 and 2 at Stockholm Central Station.

Another option is the commuter train. Tickets can be purchased at the airport. The commuter train also arrives at and departs from Stockholm Central Station (and other stations on the way). The commuter train takes about 40 minutes, and the train departs every 30 minutes.

## Bus

Flygbussarna Airport Coaches offers affordable transfer between Arlanda and Stockholm C, with departures up to every 10 minutes throughout the day. The travel time is approximately 45 minutes. Buy your tickets online at <u>https://www.flygbussarna.se</u> for the best price.

Flixbus also runs coach connections between Arlanda and Stockholm, around two to three times a day.

## Taxi

Taxis are available and they are all eco-taxis. The Swedish taxi market is deregulated, so free price setting applies to taxi rides in Sweden Request fixed pricing from airport to downtown; the cost is about SEK 675, and the journey takes about 30 minutes.

# 6. Visa information



Participants from countries requiring an entry visa for Sweden (Schengen visa) are strongly advised to contact the nearest Swedish diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure. **Please note that airline companies will not allow boarding in the absence of a valid visa**.

## 8. Payment of the Daily Subsistence Allowance (DSA)

The DSA will be disbursed to sponsored participants on the first day of the workshop in the form of a prepaid credit card. For identification purposes, these participants are kindly requested to bring their passports and boarding passes. These will be photocopied and returned to participants during the workshop. It is advisable that participants have some cash at hand to cover expenses that may occur between their arrival and the moment at which the prepaid credit card they are provided with is activated.

## 9. Official languages

The official main language in Sweden is Swedish. However, there are five national minority languages: Finnish, Yiddish, Meänkieli, Romani and Sami. English is widely spoken in Sweden.

## 10. Weather and time zone information



In September average temperatures in Stockholm usually range between a maximum of  $+15^{\circ}$ C in the daytime and a minimum of  $+9^{\circ}$ C at night. The standard time zone in Sweden is Central European Summer Time (CEST) equivalent to GMT/UTC +2 hours.

## 11. Electricity

The electrical currents in Sweden are 230 Volts, 50 Hertz. The plugs are as shown in the illustrations below:



# 12. Currency

The currency in Sweden is the Swedish krona (SEK). The current exchange rate as at 11 June 2019 is US 1 = SEK 9.441 and  $\in 1 = SEK 10.692$  (rates are subject to change, source: www.xe.com).
