

1. Opening and registration

5. General information on access to Amman, Jordan



Amman is serviced by the Amman, Queen Alia International airport which is about 26 km from the city centre. Taxis are available at the arrivals hall of the airport and the cost to downtown Amman is about US \$35.00. Taxi fares are fixed and the prices are displayed near the designated taxi park at the airport's terminal exits.

6. Visa information



Participants requiring visa for entry into Jordan are strongly advised to contact the nearest Jordanian diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure.

To facilitate the issuance of visas, the Secretariat will issue upon request invitation letters to be attached to the visa applications.

7. Health information and COVID 19

An international certificate of vaccination for yellow fever is required for all travelers arriving from a yellow-fever infected area.

All travelers should be up to date with their COVID-19 vaccines, no testing is required to enter the country. It is suggested that you always carry proof of vaccination and masks while travelling. Caution is required where risk for COVID-19 infection is high, such as in crowded, poorly ventilated spaces or personal risk from COVID-19 is high. Preventive measures such as keeping up to date with COVID-19 vaccinations, practicing hand hygiene, and using face masks are advised.

9. Payment of the DailySubsistence Allowance (DSA)

The DSA will be disbursed to funded participants on the first day of the meeting in the form of a prepaid credit card (Swiss Bankers card). These funded participants are kindly requested to bring their passports and boarding passes on the first day of the meeting. These will be recorded and returned to participants during the meeting. It is advisable that participants have some cash at hand to cover expenses that may occur between their arrival and the moment at which they are provided with the prepaid credit card from which they will access their DSA. Please note that the funds can take up to 48 hours to be loaded on the cards.

<u>IMPORTANT:</u> If you were provided with a Swiss Bankers card for a previous meeting, please inform the Secretariat and bring it with you to the meeting (if it is still valid) so that it may be reused. 11. Weather and Time Zone information




Weather of January in Amman can be described as "moderately chilly", the average temperature of a typical day ranges from 16°C (61°F) to a low of 5°C (40°F). The chance of precipitation in the form of rain or snow during this month is 20%. Please bring appropriate warm outer clothing and an umbrella for weather conditions.

The standard time zone for Jordan is EEST (Eastern European Summer Time) which is GMT/UTC +3 hours.

12. Electricity

The electrical current is 230 volts, 50 Hertz. There are four different plug types in Jordan as shown below.



The currency in Jordan is the Jordanian Dinar (JOD). The current exchange rate as at 12 December 2024 is US \$1.00 = 0.709 JOD and (Euro) € 1 =0.762 JOD (source: www.xe.com, rates are subject to change).
