- 7. The way forward:
 - 7.1. Mobilization of resources for the implementation of the Nagoya Protocol;
 - 7.2. Roadmaps/action plans towards ratification/accession to the Nagoya Protocol and the development or amendment of domestic legislative, administrative or policy measures;
