#### Venue

The Asia and Pacific Regional Meeting on the Biosafety Clearing-House, organized by the Secretariat of the Convention on Biological Diversity, will be held in conjunction with the UNEP-GEF Regional Workshop on Development of National Biosafety Frameworks, in Beijing, China from 4 to 8 March 2002. 4 March will be a joint introductory day, 5 to 6 March will focus on the UNEP/GEF workshop and 7 to 8 March will focus on the Biosafety Clearing-House. #### **Opening and Registration**

The official opening of both meetings will be held in the Meeting Room, 1<sup>st</sup> floor, Xiyuan Hotel on Sunday evening, 3 March 2002, at 6:30 p.m. Registration will take place at the reception desk outside the Meeting Room on Sunday 3 March 2002 from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. and will continue on Monday 4 March 2002 from 7:30 a.m. to 8:45 a.m. at the reception desk outside the Function Room, 4<sup>th</sup> floor, Xiyuan Hotel.

## Services to delegates

The Business Center of the Hotel will provide, on a commercial basis, photocopying, fax and card operated telephones and other services. Participants may also access their email, free-of-charge, at the meeting room.

#### Hotel information

A block hotel reservation has been made for all participants at the Xiyuan Hotel (four stars), the venue of the meetings. The room rate is US\$ 88/ night, including breakfast, lunch and dinner.

The hotel costs for the sponsored participants will be paid directly to the hotel by the organizers. Eligible participants will be paid an ad hoc DSA at 20% of the prevailing rate to cover miscellaneous costs. Participants who are not sponsored are requested to confirm their reservation with the hotel directly as soon as possible.

## **Transport**

The Government of China will provide a free-of-charge shuttle service to transport the participants from the Beijing Airport to the Xiyuan Hotel on Sunday 3 March 2002 and from the Xiyuan Hotel to the Beijing Airport on Friday and Saturday 8 and 9 March 2002.

Taxis are also available at the Beijing Airport to the Xiyuan Hotel (50 minutes), costing about ¥ 110 RMB(\$ 13.4 USD) for one way trip to the Xiyuan Hotel).

#### Time Zone

The Beijing Standard Time (BST), uniform throughout the country, is eight (+8) hours ahead of GMT.

#### Weather

During the month of March, highest average temperature in Beijing is  $+ 8^{\circ}$ C and the lowest average temperature is  $-1^{\circ}$ C.

#### **Electricity**

220 volts, 50 Hertz.

## Visas

Participants are required to obtain appropriate entry visa to China. Delegates are advised to check with the nearest Chinese diplomatic or consular mission regarding visa, vaccination and customs requirements.

# Official language

The official language in China is Chinese but English is understood and spoken in hotels. The meeting will be held in English only.

# Currency

The official currency in China is RMB (¥). The current exchange rate against the US dollar is approximately RMB 8.19 for one US dollar.

#### Credit cards

Major credit cards are accepted in most hotels in Beijing.

## Posters and Publications

Participants wishing to display their posters and publications during the meeting should consult with the CBD Secretariat or with UNEP/GEF directly.

# Special Events

From 1:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Wednesday 6 March 2002, there will be a cultural tour, free-of-charge, of the Great Wall and the Tiananmen Square. Delegates might also wish to visit the Beijing Opera and other places.
