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

### 1. Opening and registration

The Third Business and the 2010 Biodiversity Challenge Conference in conjunction with the UNEP Business and Industry Global Dialogue will be held from 30 November to 2 December 2009 in Jakarta, Indonesia.

The Conference will start at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, 30 November 2009, and registration will take place at the venue of the Conference at 8:00 a.m. the same day.

The conference will be followed by an informal dialogue on business and access and benefit-sharing on 2-3 December 2009, organized by the CBD Secretariat in collaboration with the United Nations University (UNU).

### 4. Access to the conference venue and name badges

### 7. General information on access to Jakarta, Indonesia



Jakarta is serviced by the Jakarta - Soekarno-Hatta International Airport (30 km from the city centre). The journey to the city centre takes approximately 60 minutes (longer during rush hour).

Participants wishing to avail themselves of the Gran Melia Silver Bird Taxi service should send the completed reservation form attached hereto, as soon as possible **but no later than Friday, 23 November 2009,** to the designated focal person namely:

The fares are approximately US \$24.50 each way or a portion of it when shared amongst 2-3 participants can be charged to the rooms. The Gran Melia airport representative will be greeting participants with a sign bearing the name of the hotel, at the gate after the baggage claim counter.

Alternatively, participants can book taxis at counters in the arrivals areas and in the main halls of the terminals and often operate on a pre-paid coupon system which can be purchased at the terminal. The cost of the fare is approximately IDR 200,000 (US \$20) to the city centre.

It should be noted that an airport tax is **applicable upon departures** of IDR 150,000 net per person (approx. US \$15). The airport tax must be **paid in local currency only**. Exchange facilities are available at the Gran Melia Hotel.

### 8. Visa information



Participants from countries listed below <u>do not</u> require an entry visa for Indonesia, all other participants are strongly advised to contact the nearest Indonesian diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, **prior to departure**. Nationals from countries which can obtain a visa on arrival are also advised to secure a visa prior to departure, as some airline companies may not allow boarding in the absence of a visa.

For ease of reference, the following documents are required for visa applications:

- A valid passport (a least 6 months);
- A round trip or through ticket to country of destination;
- 2 photographs, size 4 X 6 cm;
- Proof of written guarantee of possession of sufficient funds for living expenses during entire stay in Indonesia;
- Payment of the visa fee (as necessary)<sup>1</sup>.

# COUNTRIES AND TERRITORIES WHOSE CITIZENS <u>DO NOT</u> REQUIRE VISAS IN ORDER TO ENTER INDONESIA AS VISITORS (AS LISTED ON THE WEBSITE OF THE MINISTRY OF CULTURE AND TOURISM OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA)

Citizens of the following countries and territories **do not** require a visa to **visit** or **transit** Indonesia:

To facilitate the issuance of visas, the Secretariat will issue upon request invitation letters to be attached to the visa applications.

### 9. Health Information

There are no vaccination requirements for Indonesia except for travellers coming from a yellow fever endemic country require a yellow fever vaccination certificate for travellers over 1 year of age. For more information, please consult a medical professional with regard to the vaccination requirements for your travel.

A malaria risk exists throughout the year in all areas of the five eastern provinces of Papua, West Papua, Maluku, North Maluku and East Nusa Tenggara. In the other parts of the country, there is malaria risk in some districts, except in Jakarta Municipality, big cities, and within the areas of the main tourist resorts. P. falciparum resistant to chloroquine and sulfadoxine—pyrimethamine reported. P. vivax resistant to chloroquine reported. For more information, please consult a medical professional with regard to the vaccination requirements for your travel.

### 10. Hotel -block booking

A block booking has been made at the Hotel Gran Meliá Jakarta, the Conference venue, on behalf of all participants in the Conference. The negotiated room rates (US\$ 70 net) for a Deluxe Room in a single occupancy, inclusive of breakfast, are outlined in the reservation form attached hereto. As indicated under heading 5 above, the completed reservation form should be sent as soon as possible **but no later than Friday, 23 November 2009** to the designated focal person.

It should be noted that the block booking includes breakfast and lunch, with regard to supper, participants will have to make their own arrangements with Gran Melia or at restaurants in the vicinity. The CBD Secretariat will settle the hotel accommodation at a single occupancy rate including lunch on behalf of the sponsored participants. Any extras, such as Silver taxi service, telephone, room upgrade, bar, laundry, e-mail, restaurant, etc. are at their own costs and must be settled upon checking out.

### 11. Payment of the Daily Subsistence Allowances (DSA)

Sponsored participants will receive the relevant portion of their DSA on the first day of the Conference.

### 12. Official language in Indonesia

The official language in Indonesia is Indonesian, however English is spoken in hotels and restaurants.

### 13. Weather and time zone information

The electrical currents are 230 volts, 50 Hertz the type of socket is two round pins (with or without ground connection) as shown below.











### 15. Currency



The currency in Indonesia is the Indonesian Rupiahs (IDR or Rps.). The current exchange rate as at 13 October 2009 is US 1 = IDR 9,445.00 and (Euro) 1 = IDR 14,008.94.
