

The Sixth Coordination Meeting for Governments and Organizations Implementing or Funding Biosafety Capacity-building Activities will be held from Monday, 1 February to Wednesday, 3 February 2010 and the Seventh Meeting of the Liaison Group on Capacitybuilding for Biosafety will be held from Thursday, 4 February to Friday 5 February 2010. Both meetings will be held in Siem Reap, Cambodia. The Sixth Coordination Meeting for Governments and Organizations Implementing or Funding Biosafety Capacity-building Activities will start at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, 1 February. Registration for both meetings will take place at the venue of the meeting at 8:30 a.m. on 1 February 2010.

5. General information on access to Siem Reap, Cambodia



Siem Reap is serviced by the Siem Reap International Airport which is located 6 km from the city centre. A ticket booth for registered taxis into town is close to the temples outside the terminal. Independent taxis and motorcycles are also available just outside the airport. The price from the airport into town is standard for motorcycles (\$1) and cars (\$5). Most hotels offer free transportation from the airport but must be booked in advance.

6. Visa information

In order to visit Cambodia, a visa is required for most nationalities. A passport with at least six month validity is required. Philippine and Malaysian nationals do not require tourist visas for a stay of up to 21 and 30 days respectively. Participants from Lao, People's Democratic Republic, Singapore and Viet Nam are also exempt from the usual visa requirements. A visa on arrival is not permitted for holders of the following passports: Afghanistan, Algeria, Bangladesh, Islamic Republic of Iran, Iraq, Pakistan, Saudi Arabia, Sri Lanka, and Sudan. Holders of the above mentioned passports must obtain a visa prior to arrival in Cambodia. Holders of these passports are required to hold a letter from a sponsor or a letter of invitation from a company / organization / travel agent, and are also advised to hold a valid return ticket.

A visa can be issued on arrival at the Siem Reap International Airport at the cost of US \$25.00, and takes approximately 20-30 minutes. Also, please bring one passport sized photo and supporting documentation. 7. Health Requirements

Yellow Fever Vaccination - Travellers to The Kingdom of Cambodia should obtain a yellow fever vaccination certificate if arriving within 10 days from infected areas.

Water for drinking, brushing teeth or making ice should first be boiled or otherwise sterilized. Bottled water is widely available.

The electrical currents in Cambodia are 230 Volts, 50 Hertz. This plug has three rectangular prongs that form a triangle, see illustration below.

13. Currency



The currency in Cambodia is the Riel (KHR). The current exchange rate as at 14 December 2009 is 1,000KHR = US \$0.24 or US 1 = 4.172 KHR; and $1 \in 6,024.93$ KHR or 1,000KHR = 0.16 €.
