There are two official languages in Canada: English and French. French is the official language of Quebec; however English is widely spoken in Montreal.

In April, temperatures in Montreal usually range between a maximum of +11°C in the daytime and a minimum of -1°C at night. The electrical currents are 120 volts, 60 Hertz (two-pin, flat and vertical with ground connection).

The currency in Canada is the Canadian Dollar (CAD \$). The current exchange rate as at 12 February 2009 is US \$1 = CAD \$1.24 and (Euro) €1 = CAD \$1.59.
