

#### 9. Official languages in Montreal

There are two official languages in Canada: English and French. French is the official language of Quebec; however English is widely spoken in Montreal.

#### 10. Weather and time zone information



In April, temperatures in Montreal usually range between a maximum of  $+11^{\circ}$ C in the daytime and a minimum of  $-1^{\circ}$ C at night. The general weather conditions are cold, rainy with a possibility of light snow at this time of the year. You are advised to bring warm clothing. The standard time zone will be GMT – 4 hours. #### 11. Electricity

The electrical currents are 120 volts, 60 Hertz (two-pin, flat and vertical with ground connection).



#### 12. Currency



The currency in Canada is the Canadian Dollar (CAD \$). The current exchange rate as at 12 February 2009 is US 1 = CAD 1.24 and (Euro) 1 = CAD 1.59.
