# ANNOTATIONS TO THE PROVISIONAL AGENDA

#### INTRODUCTION

- 1. At its fourth meeting, the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Protocol (COP-MOP), in its decision BS-IV/11, established an Ad Hoc Technical Expert Group (AHTEG) on Risk Assessment and Risk Management and an open-ended online forum on specific aspects on risk assessment (hereinafter "the Open-ended Online Forum")<sup>1</sup> in accordance with the terms of reference annexed to that decision.
- 2. At its fifth meeting, in decision BS-V/12, the Parties decided to extend the current Open-ended Online Forum and the AHTEG. In the terms of reference annexed to that decision, the Open-ended Online Forum and the AHTEG are to work primarily online and the AHTEG is to meet twice face-to-face prior to the sixth meeting of the Parties with the view to achieving the following expected outcomes:
  - (a) A revised version of the "Guidance on Risk Assessment of Living Modified Organisms";
  - (b) A mechanism, including criteria, for future updates of the lists of background materials;
- (c) Further guidance on new specific topics of risk assessment, selected on the basis of the priorities and needs by the Parties and taking into account the topics identified in the previous inter-sessional period.
- 3. At its third meeting, held in Mexico City from 30 May to 3 June 2011,<sup>2</sup> in discussing outcome (c) above, the Group agreed to develop guidance on the first two topics of a list resulting from the priority-setting exercise conducted in the Open-ended Online Forum, namely:
  - (a) Monitoring of LMOs released into the environment; and
  - (b) Risk assessment of living modified trees.
- 4. At that meeting, the Group also agreed to establish two sub-working groups (SWGs) on the choosen topics and developed outlines as basis for further discussions on the development of these

guidance documents. The Group also developed an action plan<sup>3</sup> which contains a detailed summary of the activities to be followed prior to its fourth meeting tentatively scheduled to take place in June 2012.

- 5. In accordance with its mandate and action plan, the AHTEG SWGs have been working closely with the Open-ended Online Forum in order to draw on the additional scientific expertise available in the Forum. Three rounds of online discussions were carried out between July 2011 and January 2012 for continuous improvement of the guidance documents on "Monitoring of LMOs released into the environment" and "Risk assessment of living modified trees".
- 6. As a result of the collaborative work between the AHTEG SWGs and the Open-ended Online Forum, the fourth draft of the guidance documents on "Monitoring of LMOs released into the environment" and "Risk assessment of living modified trees" were developed.
- 7. In view of the experience gained from a previous face-to-face meeting of the SWGs in facilitating the development of guidance documents and following the generous offers from the Government of Germany to host a similar meeting and from the Government of Norway to provide financial support, the "Meeting of the Sub-Working Groups of the Ad Hoc Technical Expert Group on Risk Assessment and Risk Management" will be held in Bonn, from 13 to 15 February 2012.
- 8. The draft documents on "Monitoring of LMOs released into the environment" and "Risk assessment of living modified trees" will be placed before the SWGs for improvement with a view to achieving the outcome outlined in paragraph 2(c) above.<sup>4</sup>

9. The Chair of the AHTEG will open the meeting at 9: a.m. on Monday, 13 February 2012. The opening of the meeting will be followed by short remarks from a representative of the host Government and the Secretariat.
