

5. General information on access to Nadi, Fiji

The city of Nadi is serviced by the Nadi International Airport in Nadi, Fiji (about 8 km from Nadi Town). It is located on the West of Viti Levu and the capital Suva is located to the East. Participants will be staying at the Hotel Novotel Nadi which is located close to the airport. Shuttle services from the Hotel Novotel Nadi are available.

6. **Visa information**



Participants from countries listed below do not require an entry visa for Fiji all others are strongly advised to contact the nearest Fijian diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure.

Citizens of the following countries **do not** require a visa for Fiji for a stay of up to 4 months:

Antigua and Barbuda, Argentina, Australia, Austria, Bahamas, Bangladesh, Barbados, Belgium, Belize, Bermuda, Botswana, Brazil, Brunei Darussalam, Bulgaria, Canada, Chile, China, Colombia, Cook Islands, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Dominica, Estonia, Finland, France, Gambia, Germany, Ghana, Greece, Grenada, Guyana, Holy See, Hungary, Iceland, India, Indonesia, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Jamaica, Japan, Kenya, Kiribati, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lesotho, Luxembourg, Malawi, Malaysia, Maldives, Malta, Marshall Islands, Mauritius, Mexico, Micronesia (Federated States of), Moldova, Monaco, Nauru, Netherlands, New Zealand, Nigeria, Norway, Palau, Papua New Guinea, Paraguay, Peru, Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Republic of Korea, Romania, Russian Federation, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Samoa, Serbia, Seychelles, Sierra Leone, Singapore, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Solomon Islands, South Africa, Spain, Swaziland, Sweden, Switzerland, Tanzania (United Republic of), Thailand, Tonga, Trinidad and Tobago, Tunisia, Turkey, Tuvalu, Uganda, Ukraine, United Arab Emirates, United Kingdom Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America, Uruguay, Vanuatu, Venezuela, Zambia, Zimbabwe.

To facilitate the issuance of visas, the Secretariat will issue upon request invitation letters to be attached to the visa applications.

7. **Health Requirements**

A yellow fever vaccination certificate is required from travellers entering Fiji within 10 days of having stayed overnight or longer in countries with risk of yellow fever transmission.

For more information, please consult a medical professional with regard to the vaccination requirements for your travel.

8. **Hotel information**

9. Payment of the Daily Subsistence Allowances (DSA)

Sponsored participants will receive the DSA on the first day of the workshop.

10. **Official languages in Fiji**

The official language in Fiji is English, however, Bau Fijian, and Hindustani are also spoken.

11. Weather and time zone information

In November, temperatures in Nadi usually range between a maximum of 30°C in the daytime and a minimum of 21°C at night. Current weather conditions can be found at: http://www.worldweather.org/022/c00094.htm.

The standard time zone will be GMT/UTC + 12 hours.

The electrical currents are 240 volts, 50 Hertz and the plugs and are shown below.



13. Currency



The currency in Fiji is the Fijian Dollar (FJD \$) (F\$). The current exchange rate as at 25 October 2011 is US $$1.00 = \text{FJD} $1.77 \text{ and} = \text{\textsterling}1.00 = \text{FJD} 2.46 .
