South African currency consists of five notes, namely R200, R100, R50, R20 and R10. There are six coins, namely R5, R2, R1, 50c, 20c, and 10c. Money can be exchanged into rand either at banks or foreign exchange bureaux. Proof of physical address may be required for transactions.
