# 5. General information on access to Dar es Salaam, United Republic of Tanzania



Dar es Salaam is serviced by the Dar-es-Salaam - Julius Nyerere International Airport (30 km from city centre). The approximate fare from the airport to the city centre is TZS 30,000 or US \$20.

## 6. Visa information



Participants are required to obtain an entry visa for Tanzania prior to entry in the country. There are only a few exceptions for non-commonwealth countries. You are strongly advised to

contact the nearest Tanzanian diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure.

A yellow fever vaccination certificate is required from travellers coming from countries with risk of yellow fever transmission.

Risk of Malaria exists throughout the year in the whole country. For more information, please consult a medical professional with regard to the vaccination requirements for your travel.

### 10. Payment of the daily subsistence allowances (DSA)

Sponsored participants will receive DSA on Monday, 25 March 2013.

<u>Please bring your passport and boarding passes on the first day. These documents</u> will need to be photocopied in order to process the DSA payments.

# 11. Official languages in Tanzania

The two official languages in Tanzania are Swahili and English.

# 12. Weather and time zone information



In March, temperatures in Dar es Salaam usually range between a maximum of  $+32^{\circ}$ C in the daytime and a minimum of  $+23^{\circ}$ C at night. The rainy season in Tanzania is from March to May, please bring appropriate clothing. The standard time zone for Tanzania is GMT/UTC +3 hours.

The electrical currents are 220-240 Volts, 50 Hertz. The plugs used are shown in the pictures below.



# 14. Currency



The currency in Tanzania is the Tanzanian Shilling. The current exchange rate as at 8 March 2013 is US \$1 = TZS 1,621.47 and  $$\in 1 = TZS 2,106.05$ .
