Aspirations for the National Clearing House Mechanism

Overview of the Current Situation

- SVG does not currently have a national clearing house mechanism
- The 4th National Report identified the creation of a CHM as a priority for improving implementation of the Convention.
- The development of a CHM is a component of our NBSAP Revision and 5th National Report Umbrella Project.

- The CHM would be the responsibility of the Environmental Management Department, MoHWE but several government departments would provide information (Forestry, National Parks, Agriculture, NGOs)
- The MoHWE has a dedicated IT team which could provide technical support. However, day-to-day content management would be the responsibility of the EMD. (Training necessary)
- There is capacity for the MoHWE's website to be linked to a CHM.

- make key biodiversity information and knowledge available to both governmental and non-governmental stakeholders and the general public,
- enable them to track the implementation of the National Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan (including activities undertaken by various stakeholder agencies), and
- track progress towards the achievement of the National Targets

- The CHM should contain reports on activities being undertaken nationally which contribute to different objectives of the NBSAP
