### INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS

### 1. Opening and registration

The Central and Eastern Europe Meeting on the Clearing-House Mechanism and the European Community Clearing-House Mechanism will be held in Prague from Tuesday, 9 to Thursday, 11 September 2003.

The meeting will start at 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday, 9 September, and registration will commence at the venue of the meeting at 9 a.m. the same day.

## 2. Venue

### 3. Working languages of the meeting

The meeting will be held in English and Russian.

### 4. Access to Prague - Pruhonice

Prague is serviced by the Ruzyne airport (10 km from downtown). The Government of the Czech Republic will provide, *free of charge*, a shuttle service from the airport to Pruhonice based on arrival details provided by the participants on their registration forms. **Upon arrival** at the Ruzyne airport, **please look for a «CHM meeting» sign** 



Participants wishing to make their own transportation arrangements may use:

- (a) Taxis readily available for hire (1500 CZK) from Ruzyne to Pruhonice;
- (b) Bus service, operating every 15 minutes to the city centre (12 CZK for a single ticket). The journey is about  $1\frac{1}{2}$  hour. Either:
  - (i) Take bus **No.100 to Zlicin**, the end of the metro line "B" (metro costs 12 CZK for a single ticket). **From Zlicin** proceed to **Florenc station** (about 25 minutes); then change to line "C" **direction "Haje**" about 20 minutes to Opatov station. Once **in Opatov station**, take bus No. 325, 363 or 385 (departures every 15 minutes) to Prunonice–square (journey takes about 9 minutes); **or.**
  - (ii) Bus No. **119 to Dejvicka** metro line "A. **From Dejvicka** proceed to Muzeum (10 minutes), change to line "C" **direction "Haje**" (20 minutes to **Opatov station** from where same buses to Prunonice–square operate as indicated above).

Participants travelling by train will be arriving in Prague at the <u>Main Station</u> or <u>Holesivice Station</u>; both are on the Metro **line C**. For direction (namely **'Haje''**) and bus to take, please refer to (b) (i) above.

# 5. Accommodation in Praguea-Pruhonice

Hotel Floret located in the Congress Centre, the venue for the meeting and hotel Tulipan, which is about 5 minutes walk from the Congress Centre, are offering participants the following special rates (per night):

\* Single room: 1 550 CZK; \* Double room: 1 950 CZK).

The rooms are all equipped with bathrooms, satellite TV, fridges and safes. Breakfast and access to the swimming pool are included in the price. Sauna, solarium, laundry, and public hternet workstation situated in the lobby of the hotel are available on commercial basis.

The host country made a bulk pre-booking for 47 rooms on behalf of the participants in Hotel Floret and Hotel Tulipan. As a contingency measure, another pre-booking for 20 single rooms has also been made in Hotel Furohotel.

Eurohotel, about 7 km away from the meeting venue, is offering the same room rates. It should be noted that the host country will only provide transportation from Eurohotel to the venue of the meeting and back in the event that hotels Floret and Tulipan have insufficient capacity to accommodate all participants.
