Overview of SPREP

- Secretariat of the Pacific Regional Environment Programme
 - Has **26** member countries, 21 Pacific Islands Countries and Territories + 5 Metropolitan Countries (USA, New Zealand, Australia, France & UK)
 - based in Apia, Samoa, 90+ staff members
 - 4 Strategic Priorities : Waste Management & Pollution Control, Climate Change, Environmental Monitoring & Governance and Biodiversity & Ecosystems Management

The Challenge

- Unsustainable – subject to donor funding except for the PEIN
- Maintenance
- Clarification of roles and responsibilities
 - for collating/analysing/filtering/repackaging/ dissemination and updating of information

The Challenge ->Regional level

- Human capacity limitations
 - Lack of trained staff, high staff turnover, low status of information work in the region
- Technology – limited ICT infrastructure, lack of trained IT staff to support govt. depts.
- Connectivity – slow, unreliable and expensive internet (*some*)
- Poor national and regional infrastructure and support for knowledge management
- Lack of adequate policies for information sharing on both national/regional level
- Duplication of efforts

The way forward

- Utilise existing platforms, systems
- National portals -> Regional -> CBD
- Share lessons learnt from other regions eg. Africa, Europe, Asia etc, Australia, NZ?
- Information management to recognize as a priority on the regional agenda/goals

Assistance/Support

- Training/Capacity building in information/knowledge management
- Develop national/regional information policies/guidelines/frameworks/processes for the CHM
