Comments on national situation
<p>Currently, Tuvalu have only designated the focal point for the national CHM but not yet established a web site for the Clearing House Mechanism. However, so far we are using the database as a mean of storing our information for the Department, which involve all other related environment issues such as climate change, waste, water, agriculture, fisheries and so on.</p> <p>This training workshop on CHM have given us the opportunity that there is a need to establish a national CHM as this is one of the outcome of our Tuvalu National Biodiversity Strategic Plan. Given the urgent of the needs, the lack of personnel in the Department is our biggest challenges. The Department newly structure haven't been approved by the Cabinet in the past years and we hope it will be approved next year. Alternatively, the department relies on project in terms of recruitment an Information Knowledge Management Officer so that this officer will responsible in updating this database. The CCCPIR project funded by the GIZ is the first project that initiated the database for the department, however the project finished on December last year and so the Department is looking for the Ridge to Reef project to continue what have been done by the CCCPIR.</p> <p>Ultimately, the Department is strongly need a permanent post for this position. This officer will overlook in implementation and update the national CHM</p>

Strategic Vision
<p>Tuvalu National Biodiversity Strategic Action Plan (TNBSAP) clearly stated that the establishment of a CHM will enable us to achieve our commitment and obligation that stipulated in the CBD.</p> <p>However, it sad to know that the TNBSAP is now on the revision phase and we are 0% in achieve our CHM goals. Thus, this training workshop is a best time to implement our national CHM. Since I was the Acting Biodiversity Officer, firstly, I need to liaise first with my superior or the national focal point for CHM. I do believe that having CHM in place is one of a milestone for our TNBSAP.</p> <p>The CHM tool that we used in the training is perfectly good tool to start our national CHM. However, we are appreciated if the tool can contextualise so that it can capture all the sectors that under the Department such as information on Environment Impact Assessment, Ozone Depleted Substance, Waste &amp; Pollution substances (e.g POPS, Mercury), Land Degradation and Biodiversity. Information on Climate Change will not upload in this tools since Climate Change have their own unit by itself and also they have their own Information Officer in place. Last but not the least some information on NGOs that have some biodiversity related projects and activities.</p> <p>The Department should enforced the procedure of sharing information so that the officer that responsible in manage or update the website have clearly understanding on his/her duties or roles. Also the Department should develop an MOU so that whenever there is information is shared each parties should satisfy and agreed before it published. This is a way of promoting transparency.</p> <p>Once the tools is launch there should be an awareness training to stakeholders. This is to get them in the loop and also to understand the main purpose of the tools. The line Ministries should also aware in this tools so that the information can share across sectors. Thus, the mainstreaming of any biodiversity related issues into their plans and policies wouldn't be a problem.</p>
