INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS

The eighth meeting of the Subsidiary Body on Scientific, Technical and Technological Advice (SBSTTA-8) and the Open Ended Inter-sessional Meeting on the Multi-Year Programme of Work of the Conference of the Parties up to 2010 (MYPOW) will be held back-to-back in Montreal, Canada, on Monday, 10 March to Friday, 14 March, and Monday, 17 March to Wednesday, 20 March 2003, respectively.

The official opening for **SBSTTA-8** will be on Monday, 10 March, at 10:00 a.m. and registration will commence on Sunday, 9 March, between 10:00 am and 6:00 p.m.

The official opening for **MYPOW** will be on Monday, 17 March, at 10:00 a.m. and registration will commence on Sunday, 16 March, between 3:00 pm and 6:00 p.m.

Delegates are kindly requested to pre-register in order to facilitate the registration process.
