IPBES has been established as a science-policy interface:

- Supporting that research is policy-relevant
 - Responds to clearly identified needs of policy makers
 - Incentives? Alignment with research donor priorities?
- And that science is communicated to policy makers
 - Intermediaries eg NGOs, UN, SABs
 - Assessments, syntheses, policy summaries etc

Achieving these outcomes requires coordination and a *communications* interface





Intergovernmental Platform on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services (IPBES)

- Drawing on lessons from IPCC, MA, TEEB, others
- "IPCC for nature"
- Agreed to establish in Busan, June 2010
- Welcomed at CBD CoP 10
- Established by UN General Assembly, Dec 2010
- To be operationalized by UNEP in consultation with UNDP, UNESCO, FAO, MEAs and other relevant orgs.
- 1st plenary Oct (?) 2011, to put in place structures and procedures
- Substantive work initiated in 2012?...





Busan agreed on 4 functions for IPBES:

- Identify and prioritize key scientific information needed for policymakers and catalyze efforts to generate new knowledge
- Perform regular and timely assessments (global, regional, subregional and thematic)
- Support policy formulation and implementation by identifying and promoting development of tools and methods
- Prioritize key capacity building needs to improve science-policy interface







Next steps:

- UNEP Governing Council, 21-24th Feb 2011
 - Provide mandate to UNEP ED to convene 1st plenary
- First plenary (Oct? 2011)
 - Governance, Rules and Procedure, Provisional Budget, Initiate hosting arrangements
- Second plenary (Q2 2012?)
 - Hosting arrangements, work programme and budget
- All need to focus on meeting the needs of governments and other decision makers







Options for discussion:

- Role of Chairs in preparations for 1st plenary
 - Involvement with secretariats in consultation group?
- Options for relationship of MEA science bodies to IPBES
 - Inform 1st plenary, discussed at 2nd plenary.
 - Common procedure for interfacing? Requirement for MEA-specific outputs? Clear "user needs" process in design and delivery of work.
- IPBES governance
 - Involvement of chairs of SAB in IPBES governance? Science Panel?
- IPBES work programme
 - 2nd plenary, but guidance earlier helpful on focus and scope of work programme
