Brasilia is serviced by the Brasilia International Airport – Presidente Juscelino Kubitschek (about 12 km from the city centre). Taxis are available at the airport. Please note that in Brasilia, taxi fares can only be paid in cash (local currency), credit cards are not accepted. The rate for the trip to the city centre is approximately R\$50 (Approx. US \$20) and the journey takes approximately 15 minutes.

#### 6. Visa information

Participants from countries listed below <u>do not</u> require an entry visa for Brazil. Participants from all other countries are strongly advised to contact the nearest Brazilian diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa, including transit ones, in a timely manner, prior to departure. To facilitate the issuance of visas, the Secretariat will issue **upon request** invitation letters to be attached to the visa applications. The visa application process can be lengthy, so please allow sufficient time. Some airline companies will not allow boarding without a valid visa.

#### 7. Health information

In accordance to the World Health Organization procedures, Brazil is listed both as a country with risk of yellow fever transmission and a country requiring yellow fever vaccination for travellers coming from countries with risk of yellow fever transmission.

Therefore, in accordance to the regulations of the Ministry of Health, **participants who reside in or who have recently visited any of the countries listed below** must possess an International Certificate of Vaccination or Revaccination against Yellow Fever, which will be required upon arrival in Brazil.

The vaccination, valid for ten years, must have taken place at least 10 (ten) days prior to disembarkation in Brazil.

Malaria is present in most forested areas below 900m within the nine states (Acre, Amapá, Amazonas, Mato Grosso, Maranhaõ, Para, Rondonia, Roraima, and Tocantins), and also occurs on the periphery of some large cities (Belem, Boa Vista, Macapa, Manaus, Maraba, Porto Velho, and Santarem). There is no recorded transmission at Iguassu Falls.

For more information or your vaccination requirements for Brazil, please consult a medical professional with regard to the vaccination requirements for your travel.

#### 8. Hotel information

A listing of recommended hotels in the vicinity of the meeting venue can be found in Annex A below. Participants are requested to make their hotel bookings as soon as possible as it is high season at this time of the year in Brasilia.

### 9. Payment of the daily subsistence allowance (DSA)

Sponsored participants will receive their DSA on the first day of the meeting.

### 10. Official language in Brazil

The official language in Brazil is Portuguese, however, many people understand Spanish. English is spoken is some hotels and restaurants.

#### 11. Weather and time zone information



In April, temperatures in Brasilia range between a maximum of 27°C in the daytime and a minimum of 16°C at night. Brasilia is 1,158 metres above sea level. The rainy season is during the months of December through March. Please bring appropriate attire. The standard time zone at the time of the meeting will be GMT/UTC - 3 hours. There is no daylight saving time at the moment. Time zone abbreviation: BRT – Brasília time.

#### 12. Electricity

Brazil uses two voltages: 110-127 volts and 220-240 volts. In Brasília, the voltage is 220 volts, 60 Hertz. Participants using their own electrical appliances are advised to check the voltage before use.

In general, the plugs are a two-pin type as shown in the figure below. However, it is highly recommended that participants bring their own adapters, because different types of electrical sockets are used in Brazil.





## 13. Currency and rate of exchange



The Brazilian currency is the Real/Reais (R\$). The current exchange rate as at 24 February 2014 is US\$ 1 = R\$ 2.39; R\$ 1 = US\$ 0,42 and  $\in 1 = R$ \$ 3.26.

The Real is the only legal currency in Brazil and all payments for goods or services must be made in Reais or by credit card. Visa and MasterCard are widely accepted by establishments in Brazil. Other international cards, such as Diners Card and American Express, are also accepted, although the number of establishments may be fewer. Cash and traveller checks can be exchanged in banks, travel agencies and most hotels.

#### 14. Disclaimer

The Brazilian Government and the CBD Secretariat disclaim all responsibility for medical, accident and travel insurance, for compensation for death or disability compensation, for loss of or damage to personal property and for any other loss that may be incurred during travel time or the period of participation.
