5. General information on access to Cairo, Egypt

Cairo is serviced by the Cairo International Airport which is located in Heliopolis (22 km from central Cairo). Taxis are available at the airport and there is a shuttle-bus service every 30 minutes.

Taxis and limousines are readily available for hire just outside the terminal to Downtown Cairo. Also, there is a shuttle bus service available in the airport which can take you to several locations in the area, including downtown. The price for shuttle bus service for groups or single passengers to downtown Cairo is as follows:

6. Visa information

Participants from the following countries are required to be in possession of a visa prior to arrival in Egypt: Afghanistan, Algeria, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Bangladesh, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Georgia, India, Indonesia, Iraq, Islamic Republic of Iran, Israel, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Lebanon, Macau, Malaysia, Moldova, Montenegro, Morocco, Pakistan, Palestine, Philippines, Russian Federation, Serbia, Sri Lanka, Tajikistan, Thailand, The Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Tunisia, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, Uzbekistan and all African countries.

Participants requiring an entry visa for Egypt are strongly advised to contact the nearest Egyptian diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure.

The Secretariat will provide participants with a letter to assist with the issuance of required visas for travel to Egypt.

7. Health requirements

A yellow fever vaccination certificate is required from travellers over 1 year of age coming from countries with risk of yellow fever transmission. The following countries and areas are regarded as countries with risk of yellow fever transmission; <u>Africa</u>: Angola, Benin, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Congo, Côte d'Ivoire, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Equatorial Guinea, Ethiopia, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Kenya, Liberia, Mali,

Niger, Nigeria, Rwanda, Sao Tome and Principe, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Sudan, Togo, Uganda, United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia. America: Belize, Bolivia, Brazil, Colombia, Costa Rica, Ecuador, French Guiana, Guyana, Panama, Peru, Suriname, Trinidad and Tobago, Venezuela. Air passengers in transit coming from these countries or areas without a certificate will be detained in the precincts of the airport until they resume their journey. 11. Weather and time zone information

The electrical currents are 220 volts, 50 Hertz and it is shown in the illustration below.



13. Currency

The currency in Egypt is the Egyptian Pound (EGP). The current exchange rate as at 18 December is US $1 = EGP \cdot 5.499$ and $(Euro) \cdot 1 = EGP \cdot 7.874$.
