National experience with REDD-plus

REDD+ working group was established early in 2011:

- -Comprising of officials from related agencies, with the background and knowledge on biodiversity issues in Namibia.
- -Local communities.

Works closely with the Directorate of Environmental Affairs which is the focal point involving many agencies dealing with Climate Change issues.

Planning: Establishment of Governance Structures for REDD+ and awareness activities.







National experience with biodiversity safeguards

No experience with biodiversity safeguards.

Inadequate coordination and policy harmonization with other sectors that impact on forests may hinder biodiversity safeguards.

Setbacks: Insufficient funding, limited awareness, etc.

Capacity needs: Institutional, technical, human capacity building, among others.









National experience with assessing/ monitoring impacts of REDD-plus

Impacts of REDD+ on biodiversity and local livelihoods will be assessed by:

-Comprehensive forest inventories and socio-economic assessment (studies).







Regional collaboration regarding safeguards and impact assessment

Namibia's REDD+ programme will closely collaborate with other African member states already implementing the programme, through the SADC Secretariat.
