- Department of national Parks, Wildlife and Plant Conservation will be the focal point which involves many agencies
- This WG responsibilities for cooperation between all stakeholder, capacity building, pilot project.

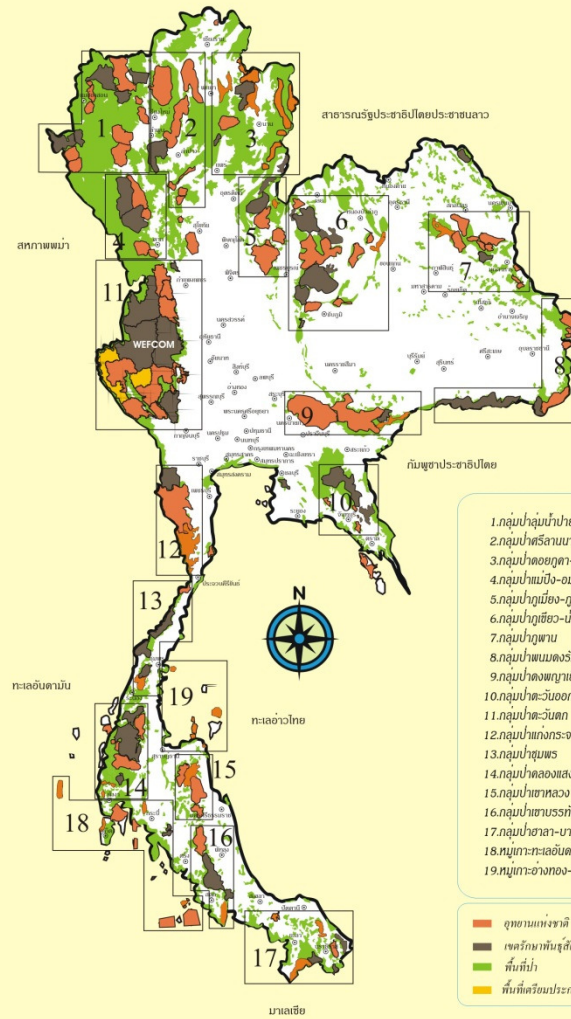
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REDD-plus pilot project

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National experience with biodiversity safeguards

the main obstacles for including biodiversity safeguards

- The main obstacles for including biodiversity safeguards is the national land use policy that seems to support the economic plantation such as Eucalyptus, rubber which is the mono crop. Therefore, it is less concern in biodiversity safeguards (invasive alien species)
- public have less concern on biodiversity safeguards, CEPA at all level



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National experience with safeguards for indigenous and local communities

civil society organizations

- the local administrative organizations around 8,000 units in almost sub-district
- also the government agencies response local communities demands to participation of the biodiversity issues management



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CBD Articles 8j (respect for traditional knowledge) and 10c (support customary use of biodiversity) reflected in REDD-plus planning and design?

NBSAPs encourage the sustainable use of biodiversity by

- protect and maintenance traditions knowledge
- measure to mitigate the impact of climate change on the biodiversity



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**planning tools for indigenous and local livelihoods to assess/monitor
the impacts of REDD-plus on biodiversity**

- involve the communities to participate in the forest communities by provide “sense of ownership” and “joint of management in protected areas”



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the National Ecological Gap analysis under the CBD

- protected area
- marine gap analysis

Forest Carbon Partnership Facilities (FCPF)

- we are on the process to approved of draft letter of forest carbon partnership facility readiness mechanism application for a grant to prepare the readiness preparation proposal (R-PP) by ministry of foreign affair to accept grant from FCPF
