5. General information on access to Helsinki, Finland



Helsinki is serviced by the Helsinki Vantaa Airport (19 km north of Helsinki city centre). Participants staying at the Scandic Paasi or Hilton Strand may take Finnair City Bus from the airport to the city centre (Helsinki railway station); from there, they can take a taxi or tram (3, 6 or 9) to these hotels. Another bus from the airport to city centre is the local bus 615. Bus 615 has a stop very close to the Scandic Paasi and Hilton Strand in the Hakaniemi district (see Annex A for map). Participants who are staying at Hotel Arthur can take either bus to the Helsinki railway station, and walk from there. Both busses depart from the airport every 20 minutes. Taxis are available outside the arrivals hall at a cost of about €30-35 to the city centre, and the journey takes about 30 minutes.

6. Visa information



Participants requiring a visa for Finland (Schengen visa) are strongly advised to contact the nearest Finnish diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure.


