

# 5. General information on access to Budapest, Hungary



Budapest is serviced by the Budapest Ferihegy International Airport (about 16 km from the city centre). There is an airport shuttle bus service to and from the airport (Airport Minibusz) that operates seven days a week, prices vary according to distances from airport and number of passengers.
