

CAPACITY-BUILDING WORKSHOP FOR SOUTH, CENTRAL AND WEST ASIA ON ACHIEVING AICHI BIODIVERSITY TARGETS 11 AND 12 New Delhi, India, 7-10 December 2015

INFORMATION NOTE FOR PARTICIPANTS

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1. **Opening and registration**

The Capacity-building workshop for South, Central and West Asia on achieving Aichi Biodiversity Targets 11 and 12 will be held in New Delhi, India from Monday, 7 December to Thursday, 10 December 2015.

The workshop will start at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, 7 December 2015 and registration will take place at the venue of the workshop at 8:30 a.m. the same day.

5. General information on access to New Delhi, India



The airport servicing Delhi is the Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGI), New Delhi. The airport is about 21 kilometres Southwest of the city centre and the journey takes approximately 30 - 60 minutes.

Taxis such as Meru Cab are available at the counter just outside the International Arrivals terminal. The cost of a taxi is approximately Rs 600 (about US \$10.00), however, there is an extra charge for taxis if you arrive after 11:00 p.m.

6. Visa information



Participants from <u>all countries require an entry visa for India</u> and are strongly advised to contact the nearest Indian diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure. Visa requests must be made on line. It should be noted that airline companies will not allow boarding in the absence of a valid visa.

To facilitate the issuance of visas, the Secretariat will issue visa assistance letters to be attached to the visa applications.

7. Health requirements

The International travel, health and vaccination requirements for travel to India can be obtainedfromtheWorldHealthOrganization(WHO)web siteat:http://www.who.int/ith/ith_country_list.pdf?ua=1.

Travellers to India require a yellow fever vaccination certificate for travellers over 9 months of age, who within the preceding six days, have been in or have passed through any country with risk of yellow fever transmission.

Malaria risk exists throughout the year in the whole country at altitudes below 2000 metres.

For more information, please consult a medical professional with regard to the vaccination requirements for your travel.

A field trip will take place on 9 December, kindly wear comfortable shoes and clothing for the outing.


10. Payment of the Daily Subsistence Allowance (DSA)

The currency in India is the Indian rupee (INR). The current exchange rate as at 18 November 2015 is US 1 = INR 66.07 and (Euro) $\in 1 = INR 70.97$ (rates are subject to change).
