- 2) ... what for?
- 3) ... how and where?





Who?

- 1) Who are the targets (people) we want to train (define the profiles, identify the organizations, **list the names?...**)
- 2) We need to ensure that the trainees are indeed in a position to make a difference
- 3) And that they are going to apply what they have been learning
- 4) Finally that the process is going to last long enough (training of trainers?)





What for?

- Improved management of sites or networks of sites = training on general management issues?
- 2) Better implementation of the Convention and PoWPA targets = training on specific management issues?
- 3) Etc.





How?

- Training stakeholders "as usual" at different scales = to build capacities for immediate action
- 2) Mentoring of stakeholders on a long term basis = **to accompany the change and generate impacts**
- 3) Delivering info and support on a regular basis = more audience and more partnerships
- 4) Etc.
