Online is **voluntary**.

There is no specific decision from COP.

**Here are some decisions it will help support.**

**Decision X/31 on Protected Areas B. Issues that need greater attention**

- Facilitate & simplify reporting on PoWPA achievements
- Adopt a user friendly, simple, web- based reporting framework that foster periodic updates
- Recognize and communicate the value PAs in addressing CC
- Timely and appropriate use of GEF 5 funds, bilateral and other aid using PoWPA action plan as basis
- Making an economic case for attracting additional funding
- GEF and IAs streamline delivery and disbursement, align projects to national PoWPA action plans for appropriate and focused interventions and continuity of projects





## **Decision X/31 on Protected Areas**

### **A. Strengthening National, Regional and Global implementation**

- Action plan for PoWPA
- Development of regional plans
- Organization of regional technical support networks
- Coordination of available funding and technical support
- Sub-regional and regional capacity building workshops
- Increase awareness on PA benefits and values

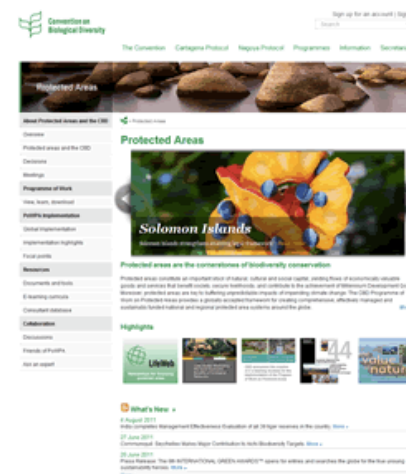

- Largely narrative format
- Allows for flexible responses
- More work to analyze
- Elements are not linked
- Not a living document
- Not as readily available

## Online

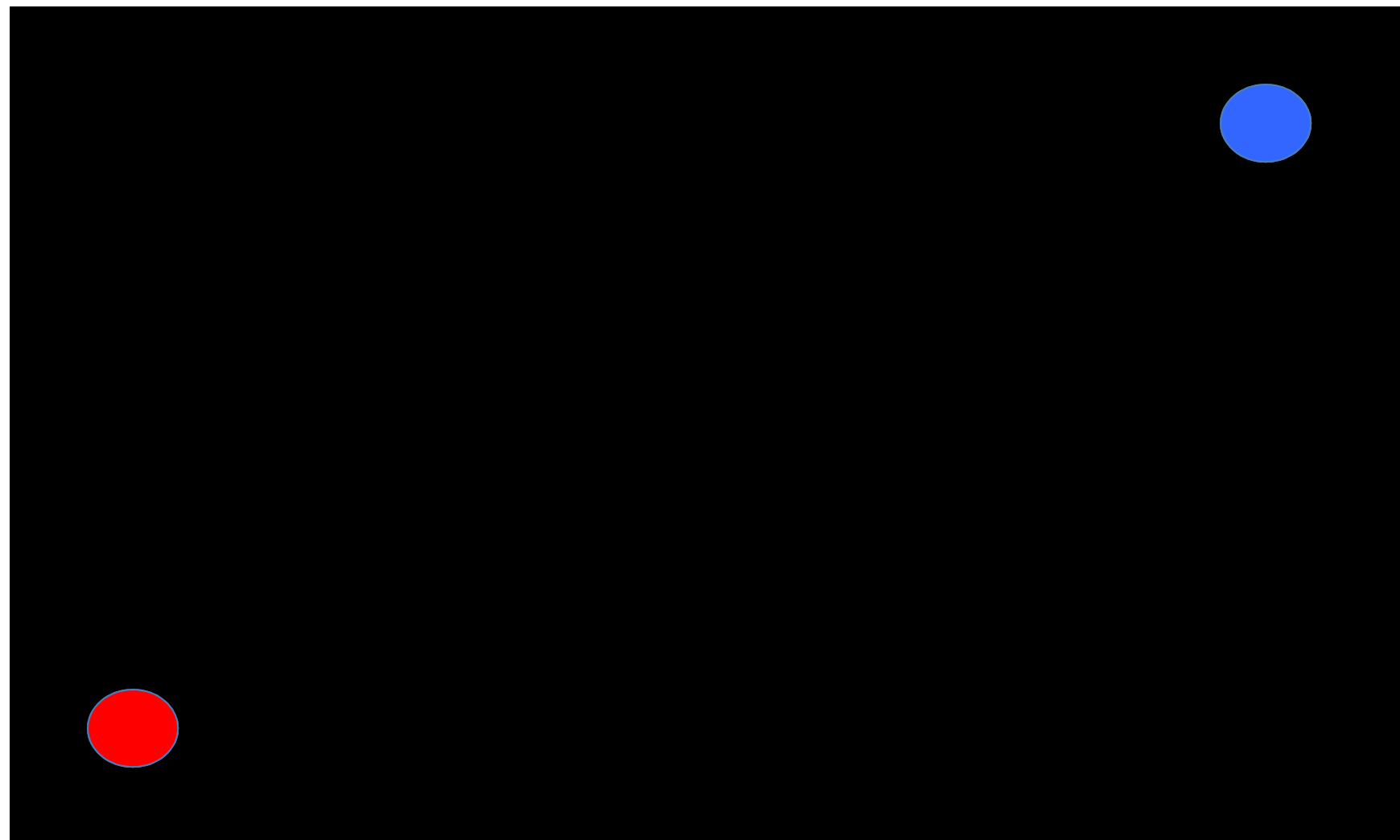
- Same content in a structured format

- Easily available and in a structured format.



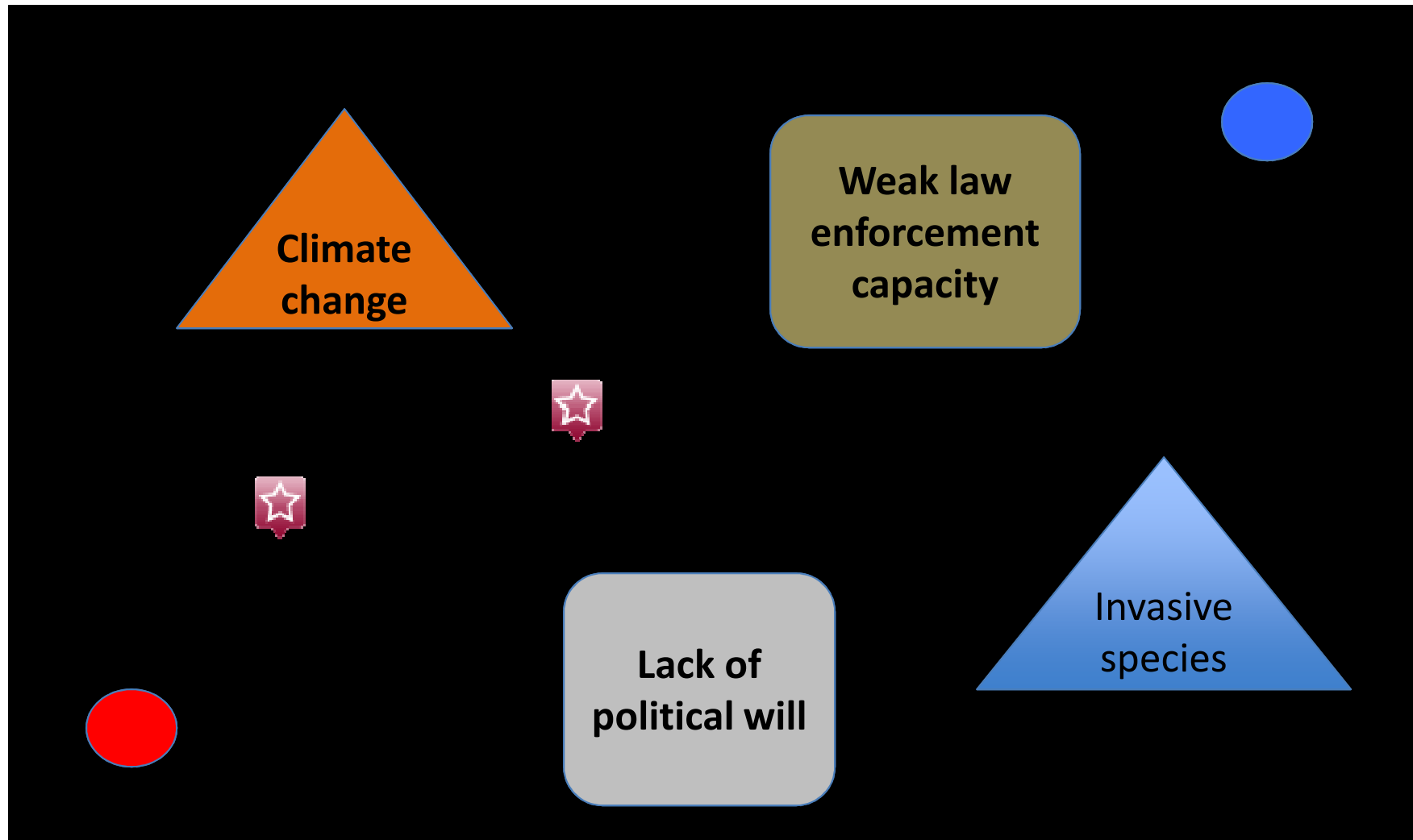

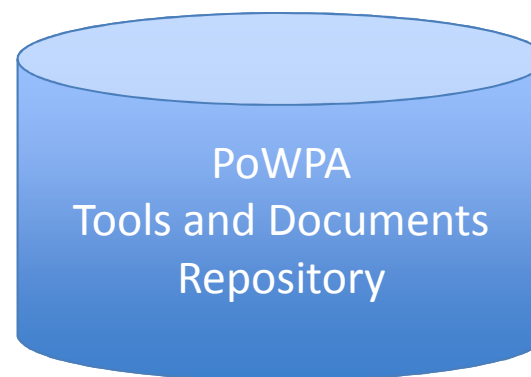
**Openly share all our information**

- Useful tools and Documents

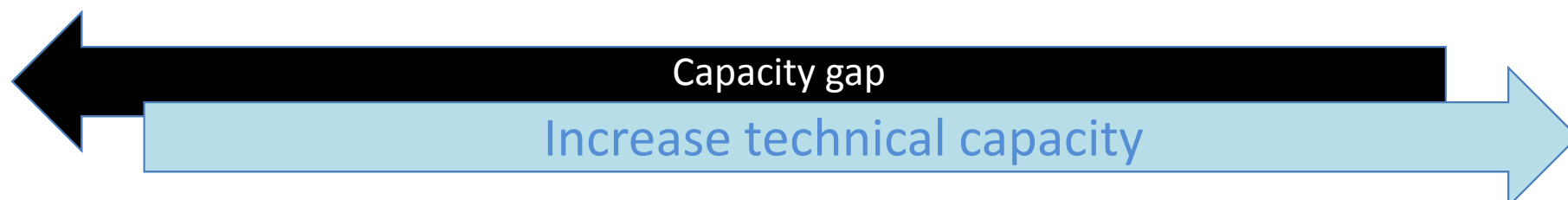


The PoWPA Tools and Documents Repository is where **information becomes more accessible to everyone.**

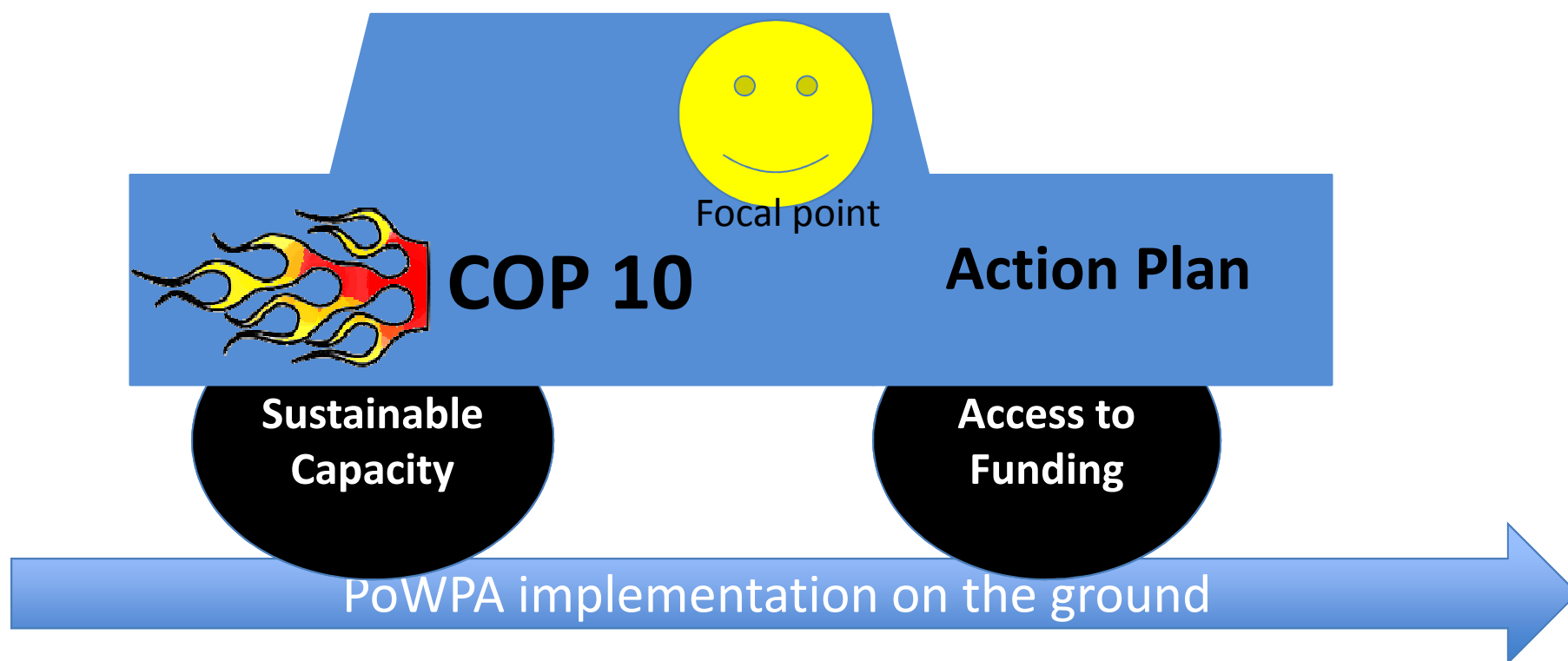
## How can a regional approach to social networking help us.

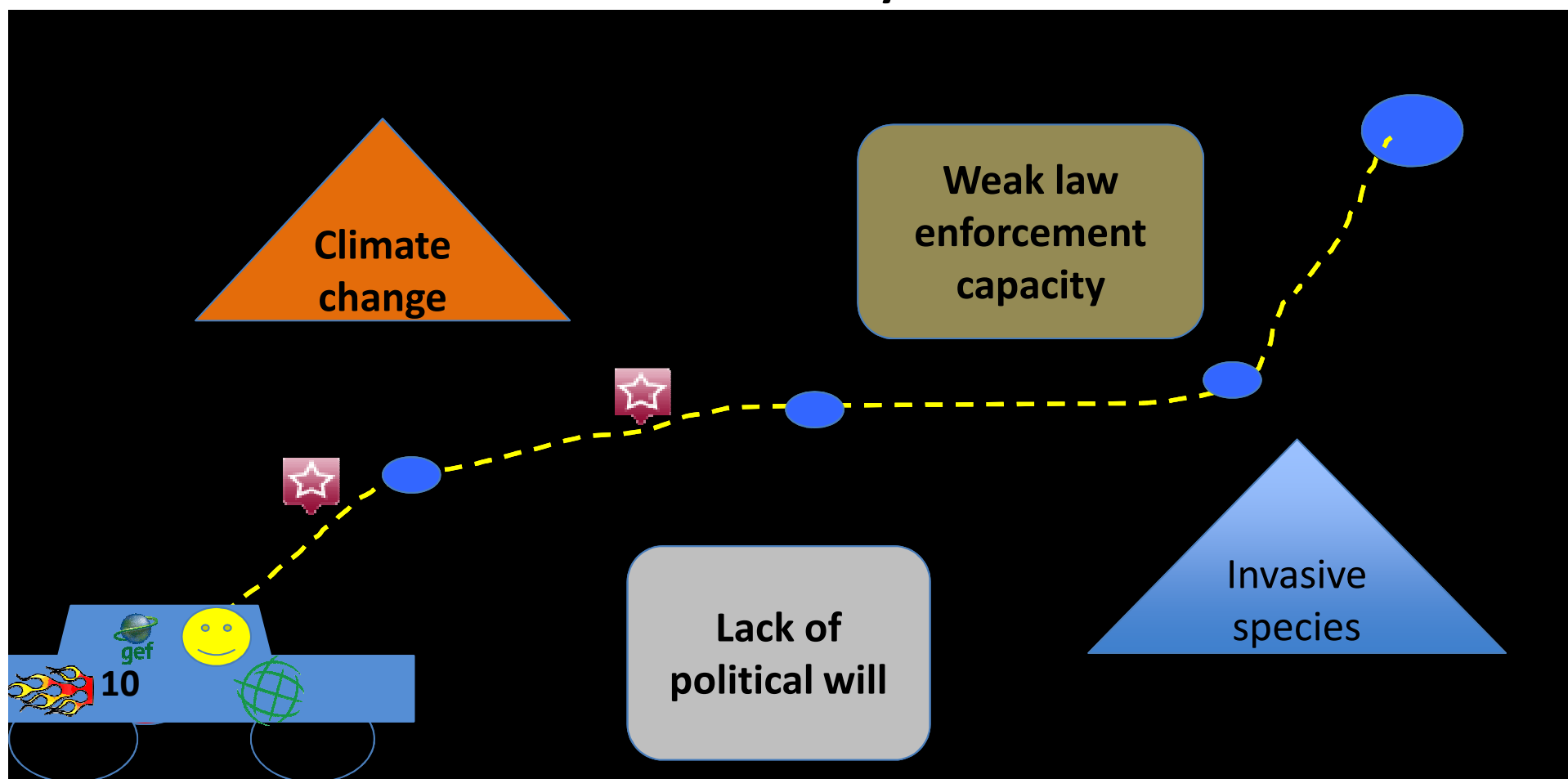

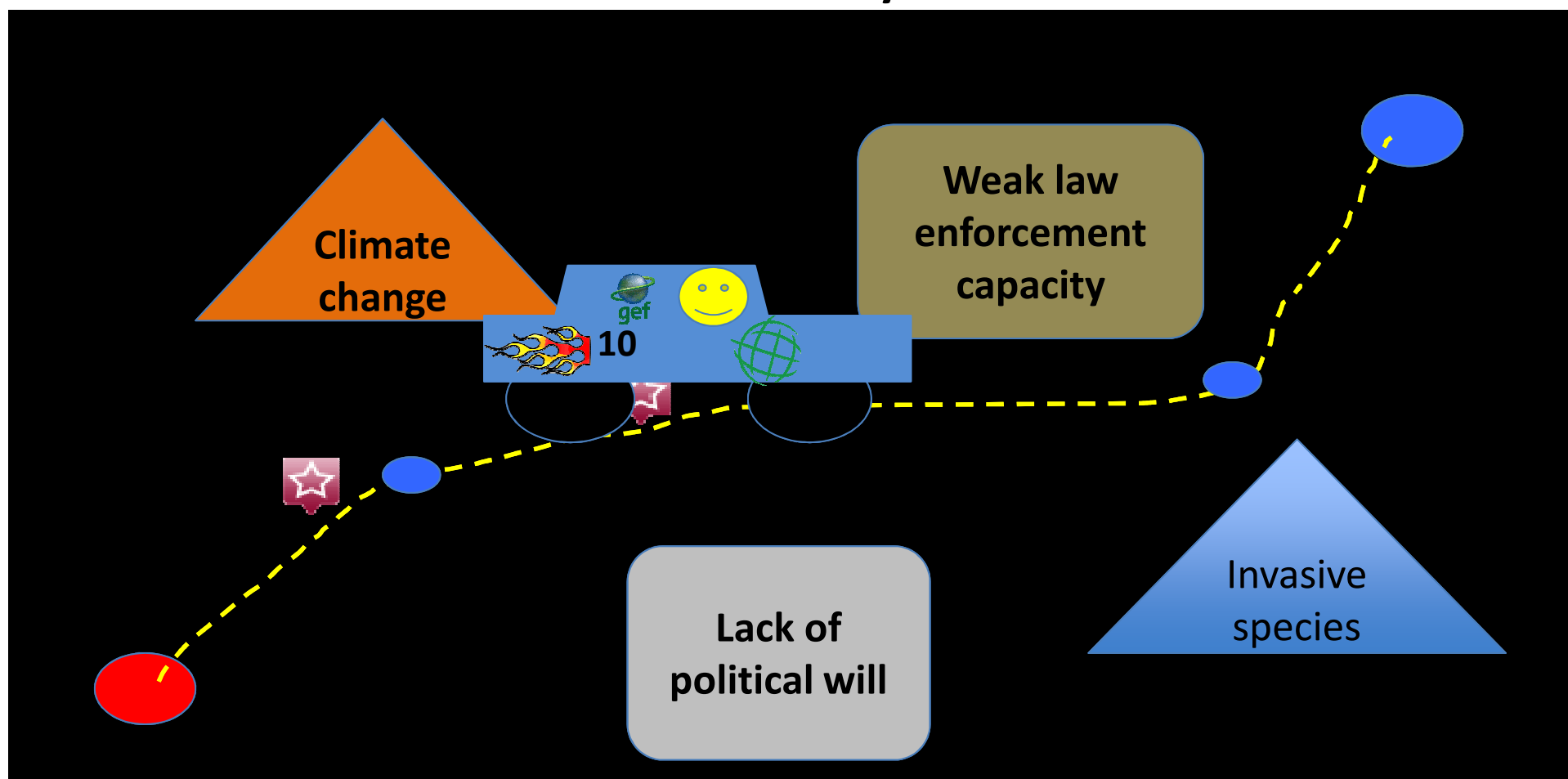
