1. Opening and registration

3. Working language and hours of the workshop

5. Visas

Participants from countries listed under **annex** attached hereto **require** a visa to enter South Africa. To facilitate the issuance of visas, the Secretariat will issue upon request invitation letters to be attached to the visa applications.

6. Arrival at Cape Town Airport

The "Cape Town International Airport" is about 20 km from the city centre. The distance from the Airport to the Lord Charles is approximately 60 km and the journey takes about 40 minutes to, depending on the traffic.

NH Lord Charles Hotel will arrange for a shuttle service from the airport to the hotel and back. The indicative rates for individual transfers are as follows:

Non-Sponsored participants are requested to provide their arrival and departure dates and times as soon as possible, but no later than 13 July 2007.

Notes:

- (1) Participants are strongly advised to use the shuttle bus service arranged by the hotel, as recognisable taxi company are difficult to identify.
- (2) Transfer fares from airport and back for the sponsored participants are paid by the CBD Secretariat.

The negotiated package on behalf of all participants is 650 ZAR (approx. 91 US\$) for a single room and 999 ZAR (approx. 140 US\$) for a double. The deal includes breakfast, two meals and VAT.
