Meeting Logistics

Venue: The meeting will be held at the National Botanic Gardens of Ireland, Glasnevin, Dublin 9, Ireland. The National Botanic Gardens are situated 3.5 km. north of Dublin city centre, more or less mid way between Dublin Airport and the city centre.
