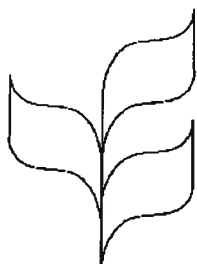

Agricultural biological diversity

In view of the fact that SBSTTA will only substantively consider agricultural biological diversity at its fifth meeting, it may wish to advise Parties and organizations to :

(a) Consider the outcome and recommendations of the two international workshops on sustaining productive ecosystems and agricultural biological diversity and on pollinators in agriculture referred to in paragraphs 74 and 75 of the document, in their preparation for the fifth meeting of SBSTTA, with a view to guiding the development of the further programme of work in this area; and

(b) Draw upon the conclusions and recommendations contained in the reports of these workshops in the implementation of decisions III/11 and IV/6 of the Conference of the Parties to the Convention on Biological Diversity.
