- Asimismo, quiero aclarar que Bolivia, además de participar activamente en este proceso, ha puntualizado enfáticamente que la propuesta del programa de trabajo del IPBES ha excluido los diferentes enfoques, visiones y modelos existentes en el mundo, como ser el Vivir Bien en Equilibrio y Armonía con la Madre Tierra. Dando lugar a un injusto y desequilibrado favorecimiento a los instrumentos de la economía verde. Por lo que recomendamos tomar en cuenta nuestros aportes.
- Bolivia considera y mantiene firmemente que para alcanzar un impacto en las acciones del IPBES a través de su Plan de Trabajo, es necesario establecer un enfoque novedoso y dinámico de gestión. Este enfoque tiene que ir orientado a fortalecer las áreas megadiversas a través de:
  - ✓ Mejorar la información científica para los hacedores de políticas tomando en cuenta las diferentes visiones y enfoques de conservación y uso sustentable de la biodiversidad
  - ✓ Fortalecer los conocimientos para realizar evaluaciones de la biodiversidad y sistemas de vida en las escalas eco regional, regional y global.
