6. Visa information



Participants from countries listed in **annex A** below require an entry visa for Canada and are strongly advised to contact the nearest Canadian diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as**

possible in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure. Please note that airline companies will not allow boarding in the absence of a valid visa.

To facilitate the issuance of visas, the Secretariat will issue upon request invitation letters to be attached to the visa applications.

8. Payment of the Daily Subsistence Allowances (DSA)

Sponsored participants will receive their DSA on the first day of the meeting. The DSA rate for Montreal is approximately US \$323 per day and funded participants will be paid DSA from 29th October until 4th December 2009, to allow participants to stay on to gain some experience in participating in the 6th meeting of the Working Group on Article 8(j) and related provisions. An additional one days DSA is provided to cover miscellaneous expenses, including visa costs and local travel. Participants may choose to stay on beyond the DSA dates, at their own expense and should arrange their travel accordingly.

9. Official languages in Canada

There are two official languages in Canada: English and French. French is the official language of Quebec; however English is widely spoken in Montreal.

10. Weather and time zone information



In October, temperatures in Montreal usually range between a maximum of 12°C in the daytime and a minimum of 2°C at night. The standard time zone will be GMT – 4 hours.

11. Electricity

The electrical currents are 120 volts, 60 Hertz a (two-pin flat and vertical with a ground connection).



12. Currency

The currency in Canada is the Canadian Dollar (CAD \$). The current exchange rate as at 1 September 2009 is US \$1 = CAD \$1.10 and (Euro) \$1 = CAD \$1.57.
