

5. General information on access to Asuncion, Paraguay



Asuncion is serviced by the Silvio Pettirossi International Airport. The airport is situated in Luque, suburb of the capital Asunción and is about 9 kms from the city centre.

Taxis are available for travel to the city of Asuncion by identified taxis and private cars called "remises". The cost of travel to the city centre is approximately US \$15 - US \$20 and should take approximately 30-40 minutes.

6. Visa information



Participants from certain countries require a visa for Paraguay and are strongly advised to contact the nearest Paraguayan diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure.

The electrical currents in Paraguay are 220 volts, 50 Hertz. The type of plug is shown in the illustration below.



12. Currency



The currency in Paraguay is the Guarani (G) and (PYG). The current exchange rate as at 12 July 2012 is US \$1 = G 4.460.00 and Euro 1 = G 5,444.06.
