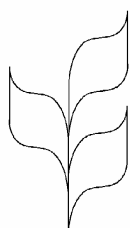

2. Registration and Identification Name Badges

Delegates are kindly reminded that for security reasons display of name badges is necessary for admission to the ICAO Conference Centre as well as the meeting rooms. In addition, delegates are requested to have personal identification documents (passport or other official documents with photograph) for entry into the conference centre.

Information pertaining to room allocations for the plenary and the two working groups as well as regional group meeting rooms will be made available on site.

3. Official opening

The official opening of the ninth meeting of the Subsidiary Body on Scientific, Technical and Technological Advice will take place on Monday, 10 November 2003, at 10 a.m.

4. Documents

13. Currency

The currency in Canada is Canadian Dollar (CND). The current exchange rate is CND 1.37 equals 1 US dollar.

14. Visa/customs
