Biosafety Clearing-House (BCH) Training Workshop, Bonn, Germany, 9-10 May 2008 (Prior to COP-MOP/4)

Dear Madam/Sir,

I am pleased to announce that the Secretariat, with the kind support of the UNEP-GEF Biosafety Project, will be convening a training workshop for BCH National Focal Points, 9-10 May 2008, immediately prior to the fourth meeting of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Cartagena Protocol (COP-MOP). This is being done in accordance with the BCH's multi-year program of work<sup>1</sup> as well as COP-MOP Decision BS-III/2<sup>2</sup>.

At the workshop, BCH Focal Points will receive comprehensive training in the general navigation of the newly revamped BCH as well as the management of national records registered in the BCH. The training workshop will be conducted in English, French and Spanish and is being offered <u>exclusively to BCH National Focal Points</u>. Kindly note that countries will not be able to substitute alternative delegates for their BCH Focal Points.

There are 80 places available for this training which will be allocated on a <u>first come first served</u> <u>basis</u> in accordance with the date of receipt of nominations. Of those, 50 are reserved for developing Party countries whose travel costs plus four days of daily subsistence allowance (DSA) will be provided.

Please send the attached nomination form, duly signed by both the BCH and the Cartagena Protocol Focal Point, <u>no later than 31 January 2008.</u> Incomplete nomination forms will not be considered.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the many governments that have been making their information available through the BCH, which currently contains over 3800 national records.
