Further to my notification reference, SCBD/BS/MPDM/ABw/64638 dated 5 September 2008, I am pleased to inform you that the deadline for nomination of experts to the Open-ended Online Expert Forum on Risk Assessment and Risk Management has been extended to **31 October 2008**.

It is noted that the participants for the Ad Hoc Technical Expert Group (AHTEG) on Risk Assessment and Risk Management will be selected by the Secretariat, in consultation with the Bureau, from among those experts nominated by Parties on the basis of their expertise, participation in the online forum and taking into account geographic distribution and gender balance. A limited number of experts from among those nominated by non-Parties and organizations will take part in the AHTEG as observers.
