NOTIFICATION

First Meeting of the Liaison Group on Bushmeat 15-17 October 2009, Buenos Aires, Argentina

Dear Madam/Sir.

The unsustainable hunting and trade of bushmeat, and their impacts on non-target species, were identified by the Conference of the Parties at its ninth meeting as an issue to be addressed as a matter of priority. The first meeting of the Liaison Group on Bushmeat is thus convened in response to element 1, goal 4, objective 2 of the expanded programme of work on forest biological diversity (decision VI/22, annex), as well as in response to the priority areas identified by the Conference of the Parties in decision IX/5 for further implementation of the programme of work.

Pursuant to Decision IX/5, I have the honour to inform you that the Secretariat is holding the **first** meeting of the Liaison Group on Bushmeat on 15-17 October 2009 in Buenos Aires, Argentina.

Invitations to nominate one participant to the workshop were sent to all Parties to which this issue is of direct relevance. I am pleased to inform Parties that the selection of representatives to receive financial assistance in order to participate in the above-mentioned meeting has been completed. Funding has been allocated to the participants listed in Annex 1 according to the following criteria:

- Representatives involved in national-level implementation of the CBD programme of work on forest biodiversity (decisions VI/22 and IX/5), and/or the development and implementation of policies and measures for the sustainable use of wildlife-based resources;
- Representatives in a position to prepare and present a brief report on challenges and opportunities to the conservation and sustainable use of bushmeat in their country;
- Working knowledge of English...
