Dear Madam/Sir,

Through notification 2012-068, dated 11 May 2012, Parties and organizations were invited to nominate experts for the advisory group for the fourth edition of the Global Biodiversity Outlook (GBO-4). A total of 50 nominations were received by 25 July 2012.

I am pleased to share with you the list of selected experts for the Advisory Group of the fourth edition of the Global Biodiversity Outlook (see Annex). The selection, made in consultation with the Bureau of the Subsidiary Body on Scientific, Technical and Technological Advice (SBSTTA), was based on expertise, regional and gender balance, taking into account the *modus operandi* for SBSTTA and relevant guidance in recommendation XVI/2.

The Advisory Group will work primarily through electronic means. However, there will be face to face meetings at key points in the GBO-4 preparation process. The first of these meetings will take place on 6 October 2012 in Hyderabad, India, taking advantage of the eleventh meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Convention on Biological Diversity.

Nominated experts who could not be selected for the Advisory Group are invited to participate in the preparation of GBO-4 by providing relevant information and reviewing draft documentation related to the report as it becomes available.
