As you know, the Government of the United Mexican States will host the high-level segment of the thirteenth meeting of the Conference of the Parties (COP-13) to the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD) on 2-3 December 2016, in Cancun, Mexico.

I am pleased to attach the provisional agenda for the high-level segment, provided by the Government of the United Mexican States, and developed in consultation with the Secretariat of the CBD. # COP 13 Convention on Biological Diversity HIGH-LEVEL SEGMENT 2-3 December, 2016 Cancun, Quintana Roo, Mexico

The high-level segment, organized by the Government of Mexico in consultation with the Secretariat of the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD), will take place on 2 and 3 December 2016.

It will set the scene and provide the necessary political impetus to make progress on specific issues, and to discuss challenges and opportunities. In addition to the Ministers responsible for issues relating to the CBD, the high-level segment will benefit from the participation of Ministers from other sectors such as agriculture, forestry, fisheries and tourism, as well as other quests.

As host of COP-13, Mexico adopted as the central theme "Mainstreaming Biodiversity for Well-being", with a focus on plans, programs, and sectoral and cross-sectoral policies, particularly in the sectors of agriculture, forestry, fisheries and tourism. The focus on mainstreaming aims to reduce, prevent and mitigate the negative impacts of the activities of these sectors on biodiversity and promote the positive ones, so as to ensure that healthy and resilient ecosystems continue to provide essential services for human well-being and for the planet, thus contributing to the objectives of the CBD, the Strategic Plan for Biodiversity 2011-2020 and its Aichi Biodiversity Targets, and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and its Sustainable Development Goals.

The outcomes expected at the high-level segment are:

- A report to the COP-13 Presidency
- Adoption of the Ministerial Declaration

The discussions will take place in plenary sessions and roundtables on each of the abovementioned sectors, where Ministers will participate as panelists. Simultaneous interpretation in the six official languages of the United Nations will be available throughout the event.
