Call for submissions for the 2016 GBIF Ebbe Nielsen Challenge

Individuals and teams are invited to develop innovative submissions and vie for more than \notin 30,000 in prizes from this incentive competition. The closing date for submissions is **29 September 2016**. GBIF will announce first- and second-prize winners—who will receive \notin 20,000 and \notin 5,000, respectively—at its annual Governing Board meeting in Brasília on 26 October 2016.
