Further to COP decision XIII/14 on climate-related geoengineering, I am pleased to inform you that the Carnegie Climate Geoengineering Governance Initiative (C2G2), in collaboration with the Secretariat of the Convention on Biological Diversity, is organizing a webinar and a one-day workshop on climate-related geoengineering. The webinar, which is taking place on 2 November 2017, will focus on the governance of research on geoengineering in the context of the Convention on Biological Diversity, while the workshop, which is taking place on 17 December 2017, will focus on transdisciplinary research and governance on climate-related geoengineering.
