Composition of the Informal Advisory Group on Mainstreaming of Biodiversity

Dear Madam/Sir,

Further to Notification 2019-006, issued on 29 January 2019, nominations were received with a view to establishing an Informal Advisory Group (IAG) on the Mainstreaming of Biodiversity, to advise the Executive Secretary and the Bureau on further development of the proposal for a long-term approach to mainstreaming biodiversity, including on ways to integrate mainstreaming adequately into the post-2020 global biodiversity framework, to be submitted to the Subsidiary Body on Implementation for consideration at its third meeting.

The selection of the IAG members has now been concluded in consultation with the COP Bureau, taking into account their relevant field of expertise and experience with due regard to geographical representation and gender balance. Please find the composition of the IAG attached.

A significant number of relevant organizations could not be accommodated into the IAG. In order not to lose their potentially significant contributions, these nominations would be maintained as part of the extended consultative network for the provision of input and feedback at important milestones of the IAG's work.
