Discussion Forum and Webinar on Criteria to Consider for Policy Options on Digital Sequence Information on Genetic Resources

Further to notification <u>2020-087</u> issued on 10 November 2020, I am pleased to announce that the Secretariat of the Convention on Biological Diversity, with the guidance of the Co-Chairs of the Openended Working Group on the Post-2020 Global Biodiversity Framework, Mr. Francis Ogwal and Mr. Basile van Havre, is organizing a fourth webinar as part of the global webinar series on digital sequence information on genetic resources and an online discussion forum, as follows:

- A webinar on Criteria for Assessing DSI Policy Options, to be held on **21 April 2021 from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. (EDT).** The webinar will also kick off the online discussion.
- An online discussion forum covering three topics:
 - o Categories of policy options, starting 21 April
 - o Potential criteria for assessing policy options, starting 21 April
 - o Policy options feasibility and appropriateness, starting 24 April

All channels will close on 2 May 2021. The discussion forum page is https://www.cbd.int/dsi-gr/forum.shtml.

The online discussion forum will enable Parties and stakeholders to share information and views on policy options and evaluation criteria that have emerged to date, noting that there may be others that have not yet been captured. It will also focus on synthesizing proposed **criteria for assessing policy options** with regard to digital sequence information on genetic resources.
