Scenario Notes - SBSTTA 24 and SBI 3

I am writing as a follow-up to notification <u>2021-026</u> on the formal meetings of the twenty-fourth meeting of the Subsidiary Body on Scientific, Technical and Technological Advice (SBSTTA 24) and the third meeting of the Subsidiary Body on Implementation (SBI 3).

Also, taking into account some difficulties with internet connectivity, it may be possible to arrange for Parties to have access to meeting facilities in UN country offices with enhanced internet connectivity to allow negotiations to proceed virtually. In this regard, for those Parties who may wish to avail such support, kindly let the Secretariat know as soon as possible, and no later than 22 April 2021, to allow the request to be made to the respective UN country offices.
