## NOTIFICATION Logistical information: SBSTTA-27 and SB8J-1 meetings

Dear Sir or Madam.

I am writing to provide some logistical information about the twenty-seventh meeting of the Subsidiary Body on Scientific, Technical and Technological Advice (SBSTTA-27) that will be held from 20 to 24 October 2025, back-to-back with the First meeting of the Subsidiary Body on Article 8(j) and Other Provisions of the Convention on Biological Diversity Related to Indigenous Peoples and Local Communities (SB8J-1), from 27 to 30 October 2025, and will be hosted by the Government of Panama.

- (2) **Registration**: To complete the online registration process, if not yet done so, representatives of Parties, other Governments and accredited organizations are requested to send their <u>official letter of nomination</u> to the Secretariat as soon as possible.
- (3) Visa: Please note that the Government of Panama has waived the visa fee to enter Panama.

## Important: The e-visa portal will be operational starting 18 August 2025.

For registered delegates that require an entry visa to Panama, please refer to the visa section of the Information Note for Participants (see above link), which includes a **visa guide** with detailed information on how to initiate the e-visa process. **Please read the visa guide carefully**.

Please also be informed that, regardless of whether a Panamanian Embassy or Consulate is present in your country, registered delegates that require entry visa to Panama are encouraged to apply directly through the e-visa portal to avoid delays.

To ensure sufficient time for review and processing of visa applications, it is recommended to apply for visa as early as possible, and no later than one month before the start of the meetings.

Kindly note that the Information Note for Participants will be updated as details become available. Participants are therefore encouraged to check back regularly for new updates.
