On August a workshop on Alien species in Viet Nam has been held at Ha Noi. The representatives from Ministries has involved:

At the workshop, all the participants has agreed that the invasive of alien species is strong danger to some provinces of Vietnam. For example: Species: Mimosa pigra, Eich hornia, Crassipes, Malalenca lencodrendron (import from Australia). Especially, Pomaca sp species (golden Neil) has destroyed a large areas of paddy field.

- Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development collaborated with IUCN for preparing the document of project at national level to address all the issue of alien species. (The proposal project has not yet been supported)
- We lack of available case-study and lack of methodology for evaluation
- We are not enough information of alien invasive species problems Tranboundary issues. Some species problems we would like to discuss with neighbour countries.

We hope that CBD secretariat will support Vietnam to engage the program international or regional on controlling the alien invasive species.
