## **Programme of Work on Island Biodiversity**

This questionnaire survey is designed to help acquire information to contribute towards the development of a pre-session document for the in-depth review of the Programme of Work on Island Biodiversity. The pre-session document will be tabled at SBSTTA 16 in May 2012.

In 2006 at the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD) Conference of Parties (CoP 8), the Parties adopted the Programme of Work on Island Biodiversity (PoWIB). Two years later, Parties at CoP 9 requested that SBSTTA undertake an In-depth review on island biodiversity to be considered at CoP 11 in 2012.

The questionnaire survey is designed to assess progress on implementation of the PoWIB around three themes:

- How has the PoWIB helped you in implementing the CBD?
- What are the obstacles and barriers in implementing the PoWIB?
- What are the priorities for capacity building to help implement the PoWIB?




