 (b) Young generation not keep to learn 8
 - (b) Young generation not keen to learn & practise traditional medication
 - © Reluctance of TK holders to pass down knowledge
- FRIM's approach is practical & beneficial to community
- Good relationship with FRIM researchers, including 1 indigenous people
