Page	Paragraph	Comment
6	0	Target 5 should be also linked to SDG 9 and, more specifically, to SDG Target 9.5. Current tools to remove and control invasive alien species such as rodents have social, ethical, ecological, and financial constraints that limit these conservation methods. Innovation is vital to address IAS' impact on biodiversity; hence the need to enhance scientific research and upgrade the technological capabilities - as proposed by SDG Target 9.5 – if we want to meet the Framework's goals and targets.
17	0	The analysis of Target 16 does not reflect the potential positive impacts of biotechnology. We suggest the following text: <i>“The GBF should reflect the need for sharing of information on biotechnology and its <u>positive and</u> negative impacts for biodiversity, as well as promote international cooperation to achieve and monitor this goal.”</i>
